Add shortcuts to windows programs in aMPed

There are many possibilities with MultiShortcut in combination with aMPed. You can actually open or execute anything you normally would do in windows, but now via aMPed. With this you can open programs with your remote or via your touchscreen.

A short description how to do this

After installing MultiShortcut plugin, you can copy the Multishortcut00.dll file and rename it to whatever you want to name it. You can find the Multishortcut00.dll file here: C:\Program Files (x86)\Team MediaPortal\MediaPortal\plugins\Windows

After copying and renaming the files (depending on how many shortcuts you need) you have to execute the DLLfix (found in the same directory).

Now you can find new plugins in the MP config under "plugins".

When you edit the plugins, you find a "plugin ID" number. This number you need later on in the amped config. Fill in the path to the .exe file as seen below:

Now in the aMPed config you can edit a button and fill in as in my example:

You can see the window ID is 7157 (the plugin id number from Multishortcut)

Give it a name in Label ID and add an image (self-created or found in the amped skin folder under Media)
